



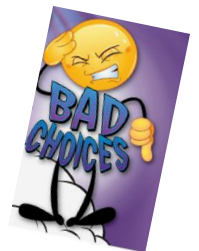
## My Home and Community Based Services Rights give me the right to make my own decisions like:

- ✓ Make choices when and where I want to go in the community.
- ✓ Have privacy, dignity, and respect.
- ✓ Say no without someone hurting me or forcing me to do something I don't want to do.
- ✓ Learn how to stay safe in my home and community.
- ✓ Say no to any services that I don't want.
- ✓ Have a job if I choose.
- ✓ Know what is written and said about me.
- ✓ Have my own money, clothing, and other personal property.
- ✓ Move about and have the freedom to go where I want in any setting (i.e. home, Habilitation, SADC, any Program, etc) including going outside and assistance will be provided if needed to keep me safe.
- ✓ Access, manage and decide how I spend my money.



## My Person-Centered Planning Rights give me the right to:

- ✓ Be in charge of my planning meeting.
- ✓ Ask anyone I want to come to my meetings.
- ✓ Choose my goals to work on and what is on my plan.
- ✓ Schedule my person-centered planning meeting at a time and place when the people who I want to attend are available.
- ✓ Pick the services I want from the choice of services I can have.
- ✓ Pick the agency I want to give me my services.
- ✓ Know that I may need help from my guardian, family and/or friends to make good choices.



## My Home and Community Based Service Rights give me the right to:

- ✓ Choose where I want to live.
- ✓ Lock my bedroom door at home.
- ✓ Have a written lease agreement for my home setting.
- ✓ If I share a bedroom at home, choose my roommate.
- ✓ Have my own room at home.
- ✓ Associate with others, have friends when I want.
- ✓ Choose what I want to do inside or outside of my home or program.
- ✓ Choose what and when I want to eat.
- ✓ Choose how my home will look.
- ✓ Be able to access all living areas of my home.





**I have the responsibility to:**

- ✓ Listen to other people's ideas
- ✓ Follow the choices I make in my plan and the choices I make about my services
- ✓ Keep myself and others safe when I'm at home and in the community
- ✓ Treat others with dignity and respect, respect their privacy and personal space
- ✓ Accept that others can say no and not force them to do something they don't want to do
- ✓ Consider how my actions affect myself and others
- ✓ Access my own money, and be aware of and manage my finances with the support needed



The Agency has one of these rights documents on file for all individuals for every service they receive.

This is just an annual reminder of the rights you have under the Home and Community Based Services Waiver.
